We are proud to announce the recent *acoustic performance certificate* awarded to us by *I.N.R.I.M. (National Metrological Research Institute)*. After carrying out a lot of research and experiments the engineers at the *Officina dei Giardini* are able to match the acoustic performance and the aesthetic beauty of any *winter garden* we produce.

The glazed partition guarantees excellent sound insulation, with an *Rw* sound insulation index of 52.5 dB. Certification was obtained from the accredited laboratory of the *National Institute of Metrology Research (I.N.R.I.M.)* in Turin. It ensures a sustainable and effective connection between external and internal using mainly iron and glass.

and thermal swimming pools, providing expert advice on the safety and comfort of the guests who use your facilities.
